For 2010-2011, Royal Oak High School did not make Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) because of reasons stated in the box below. Because our school has not made AYP for at least two years, we are identified for school improvement work.

1. **PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL:** Our students come to us by virtue of living within the boundaries of Royal Oak Schools. Also, our district opens our enrollment to school-of-choice students in grade levels K-3, who may remain in our school system for the remainder of their academic career.
2. **THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN:** Our School Improvement Team is involved in a comprehensive school improvement process that will address student learning in ELA and Math as well as some student engagement concerns. Our school plan is up-to-date and current, per requirements of AdvancEd and the State of Michigan School Improvement Office.
3. **A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL:** Royal Oak High School is a comprehensive 9-12 school with a diverse and rich curriculum available to all students. Royal Oak High School is a school with an International approach to learning. We are an International Baccalaureate candidate as a Middle Years Programme, which includes grades 9-10.

4. IDENTIFY HOW TO ACCESS A COPY OF THE CORE CURRICULUM, A DESCRIPTION OF ITS IMPLEMENTATION AND AN EXPLANATION OF THE VARIANCES FROM THE STATE'S MODEL: copies of the core curriculum are available through the principal's office.
5. IDENTIFY THE NUMBER AND PERCENT OF STUDENTS REPRESENTED BY PARENTS AT PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES: 75% of our parents regularly attend school-sponsored parent teacher conferences.

 - a. THE NUMBER AND PERCENT OF POSTSECONDARY ENROLLMENTS (DUAL ENROLLMENT) : 28 students were enrolled in postsecondary enrolled. This is 1.7% of the total population.
 - b. THE NUMBER OF COLLEGE EQUIVALENT COURSES OFFERED (AP/IB): In Spring, 2011, 271 ROHS students took 436 AP exams, which is the largest number of exams ever administered at ROHS. The percentage of students that earned a 3 or better is 70%, which is an 1% increase over the last three years.
 - c. THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN COLLEGE EQUIVALENT COURSES (AP/IB): The total number of students enrolled in AP courses was 271. This is 17% of the high school population.
 - d. THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS RECEIVING A SCORE LEADING TO COLLEGE CREDIT: 70% of our students received a score leading to college credit.
