4. Research a College of Interest and find out Application Requirements
 - **admission deadlines**
 - **essay requirements**
 - **average ACT scores**
 - **minimum GPA required**
5. Begin filling out College Applications and starting on College Essays (if required)
 - **Commonapp.com** (for **University of Michigan, Lawrence Tech, Kalamazoo College, Albion, Hillsdale, Hope**) ****early applications are encouraged! August/September**
 - **All other College Applications...** go to college of interest web site to complete an online application (keywords to look for... **Incoming Freshman, Undergraduate Admissions**)
6. Register with **Docufide.com** to send High School transcripts electronically
7. Community service (helpful to your community ...as well as your college application and scholarships)
8. Do a random act of kindness ... (i.e. Clean a room in your house without being asked.....Nice!)
9. Think about re-taking **ACT** to improve your score. Find out upcoming test dates and register at **ACT.org**
